Glenbard students excel on Advanced Placement exams

Glenbard High Schools are celebrating their students' success on Advanced Placement exams.

Glenbard West set records for the number of students testing and the number of exams taken. At Glenbard West, 308 students took 769 exams, and 76 percent earned a grade of 3 or better.

During the 2004-05 school year, 256 Glenbard North students took 442 exams and 82% scored a grade of 3 or better.

One hundred and 50 Glenbard South students took 352 exams and 88% scored a grade of 3 or better.

During the 2004-05 school year, 231 Glenbard East students took 374 AP examinations and 78 percent earned a score of 3 or higher.

At Glenbard North and Glenbard West the number of students taking the exams increased, the number of exams taken is higher and the percent earning a 3 or better has increased. Last year, 207 Glenbard North students took 390 exams and 80% earned a grade of 3 or better. At Glenbard West, 249 students took 591 exams, and 75 percent earned a grade of 3 or better.

Last year, 155 Glenbard South students took 298 exams and 89% earned a grade of 3 or better. During the 2003-2004 school year, 182 Glenbard East students took 326 AP exams and 78% earned a 3 or higher.

AP exam grades are reported on the following 5-point scale:

- 5 extremely well qualified*
- 4 well qualified*
- 3 qualified*
- 2 possibly qualified*
- 1 no recommendation**

*Qualified to receive college credit or advanced placement

**No recommendation to receive college credit or advanced placement

Through AP exams, students have the opportunity to earn credit or advanced standing at most colleges and universities.
