Glenbard to participate in Regional Summit on Civic Education

Glenbard Township High School District 87 will be participating in the 1st Annual Regional Summit on Civic Education & Responsibility, to be held Friday and Saturday, Nov. 3 and 4.

The regional summit, which will be presented by the DuPage County Regional Office of Education, will be held from 5 to 8 p.m. Nov. 3 and 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Nov. 4 in the DuPage County Government Center, 421 N. County Farm Road in Wheaton.

On Nov. 3, Glenbard District 87 students' involvement in civic engagement will be showcased. Students from all four Glenbard high schools who are involved in such activities as Model U.N., Mock Trial, Rotary International Affairs Conference, People to People Ambassadors, and the National Alliance for the Mentally Ill will be featured. Glenbard students and staff members will be available to answer questions.

On Nov. 4, a delegation of Glenbard District 87 representatives will include Glenbard North social studies chairman Jim Roberts, Glenbard East social studies department chairman Peter McGivern, Glenbard West social studies department chairman Gail Urban, Glenbard East assistant principal for instruction Terri Hanrahan, Glenbard District 87 associate superintendent for educational services Pam Zimmermann and Board of Education member Kathy Schmidt. During the summit, panelists will discuss rights and responsibilities of citizenship; the status of civic education: making the case for a DuPage County movement; and emerging trends in civic education.

Keynote speakers throughout the summit include Joan Lefkow, judge of the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois; Dawn Clarke Netsch, Northwestern School of Law faculty; and James Ryan, former Illinois Attorney General.
