Glenbard Facility Plan Review panel evaluating needs, priorities

In just three months Glenbard Township High School District 87's Facility Plan Review Advisory committee has accomplished a great deal.

The committee, which first met in February, has reviewed the 2002 physical facilities survey and toured all four Glenbard high schools to see first-hand the buildings' conditions. Committee members have developed district priorities for the facility plan and are developing building and grounds policies for each of the building priorities.

In 2002, District 87 architects developed a facility plan that provided a comprehensive list of needed building repairs and improvements. This fall, the district updated the plan with the assistance of Legat Architects, Amsco Engineering and school district administrators.

The Facility Plan Review Advisory Committee will further refine the plan and prioritize the needs. The final plan will be presented to the Board of Education Facilities/Finance Committee.

The committee's next meeting is at 6:30 p.m. Monday, May 15, in the District 87 facility center, 671 Crescent Blvd. in Glen Ellyn. At that meeting, committee members expect to complete the building and grounds policies and refine the plan to fit within the policies and priorities.

Those who volunteered to serve on the committee are community members who have engineering skills, professional construction expertise and building trade experience.

Gary Frisch, assistant superintendent of finance, is the committee chairman, and Board of Education member Tom Voltaggio serves on the committee.
