## **Classes resume at Glenbard South Sept. 7**

Power has been restored to Glenbard South High School in Glen Ellyn, and classes will be in session on Friday, Sept. 7. The early dismissal schedule for Sept. 7 will be in effect. Glenbard South was closed for one day, due to a power outage.

The following is an update regarding after-school activities scheduled for Sept. 6:

Cheerleading practices: canceled

Musical play rehearsal: canceled

Cross country: continuing as scheduled at Village Green

Golf: moved to Cantigny

Boys soccer: continuing as scheduled at the Illinois Math and Science Academy.

Girls tennis JV: canceled, due to rain

Girls volleyball: games have been moved to Kaneland High School.

Football: varsity practice will be held at 7 p.m. Lower level practice is canceled.

Market Day pickup will continue as scheduled at doors 1 and 2.

At approximately 1:45 a.m. Sept. 6 a small fire broke out on the roof of Glenbard South High School's maintenance garage. The cause of the fire was not related to the power outage at Glenbard South that occurred around 4:45 p.m. on Sept. 5.

The fire was a direct result of the overheating of the vent of the generator that ignited roofing insulation, fire officials said. The generator was in use due to the power outage. Firefighters from Lisle-Woodridge Fire Protection District and the Wheaton Fire Department responded quickly. The fire was limited to the maintenance garage roof and

no other space was affected. The fire caused minimal damage to the maintenance garage roof and will have no impact on the school reopening.

The Sept. 6 power outage occurred when three fuses failed on a transformer on Butterfield Road, near the high school.

Representatives from the DuPage County Regional Office of Education and the district's architectural engineering firm inspected Glenbard South and declared it safe for students and staff.
