14 **PURPOSE OF THIS NOTICE**

15 **YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR A PAYMENT FROM A CLASS ACTION**
16 **SETTLEMENT.**

17 **DESCRIPTION OF THE LAWSUIT**

18 This case is a class action involving late remittances and the failure to make
19 remittances of section 403(b) and section 457(b) retirement funds deducted from the
20 paychecks of certain employees of schools and colleges (the "Districts"). The
21 Defendants are Tamara Middleton and Gatekeeper Administration and Consulting
22 LLC ("Gatekeeper"). Plaintiff alleged that Defendants acted wrongfully by failing to
23 remit all Class Members' contributions to their retirement plans. Defendants deny
24 fault. The parties reached this proposed Settlement. The Class consists of the
25 following Class Members:

26 all participants and beneficiaries of section 403(b) Plans and section
27 457(b) Plans for which Defendants provided services and whose 403(b)
28 or 457(b) funds were transmitted or otherwise made available to
Defendants but were either never deposited in their 403(b) or 457(b)
retirement accounts or were not deposited in their 403(b) or 457(b)
retirement accounts in accordance with applicable Internal Revenue
Service Regulations, and/or provisions set forth in applicable contracts
or agreements, if shorter and/or in a reasonably timely and prudent
manner.

29 **SUMMARY OF THE SETTLEMENT TERMS**

30 This is just a summary of the terms. **The full terms are set forth in the**
31 **Settlement Agreement filed with the Court and available from Class Counsel.**
32 **(a) Payment of Settlement Funds and Right of Class Counsel to Seek Attorney Fees**
33 **from the Settlement Funds. Gatekeeper, through its insurance carriers, is to pay**

1 \$1,739,000,(the "Settlement Funds"). The Settlement Funds are to cover: (i) 100% of
2 unremitted retirement fund contributions of Class Members plus interest at the rate of
3 approximately 4.8% on lost earnings, with the distributions to be made to Class
4 Members' retirement accounts; (ii) \$100,000 for claims administration; and (iii) an
5 award of attorneys' fees to Class Counsel in an amount of up to 25% of the Settlement
6 Funds as approved by the Court. A separate payment in the amount of \$10,000 that
7 will not reduce the Settlement Funds will be paid by Defendants to the Named
8 Plaintiff if approved by the Court.

9 **(b) Release of Claims and Waiver of Rights. This Settlement, if approved, will
10 forever release Defendants from all claims that were alleged or could have been
11 alleged in the lawsuit, as well as release the Districts and their retirement Plans,
12 and related parties identified in the Settlement Agreement including CPI
13 Qualified Plan Consultants, Inc. and its parent company CUNA Mutual Group.
14 All Class Members, and anyone claiming through or on behalf of any Class
15 Member, will be forever barred from bringing any such claims against these
16 Defendants and entities. The Districts and retirement Plans will have to sign
17 equivalent releases releasing Defendants and other entities.**

18 **(c) Assignment of Claims. Under the Settlement, Hiscox Insurance Company, one of
19 Gatekeeper's insurance carriers, will be assigned any and all claims of Class Members
20 against their Investment Providers arising out of matters alleged or that could have
21 been alleged in the Action. The Districts and retirement Plans will have to sign forms
22 assigning their claims against the Investment Providers to Hiscox.**

23 **PAYMENT OF SETTLEMENT FUNDS**

24 **To receive a distribution of Settlement Funds, you may be required to
25 submit a Claim Form, which must be submitted by December 16, 2011.
26 Information may be obtained from Class Counsel identified below.**

27 **RIGHT TO BE EXCLUDED FROM THE CLASS**

28 **If you do not want to be legally bound by the Settlement, you must exclude
yourself from the Class by January 18, 2012. To do so, you must send written
notice to both of the following attorneys for the parties:**

40 below. **If you elect to be excluded from the Class, you will retain all existing legal
41 rights against the Defendants but you will not be permitted to obtain a recovery
42 from the Settlement Funds.**

43 **RIGHT TO OBJECT**
