Interim Questions for COVID-19 Outbreak Assessment in Schools

- Has the school developed or issued communication notifying students, staff, and families of the recently reported COVID-19 case(s) and public health recommendations/resources? If not already shared, please forward to <u>COVID19Education@dupagehealth.org</u>. <u>Reminder</u>: If DCHD is mentioned in the communication, we ask that schools please share the draft communication with DCHD for review/input *prior* to dissemination.
- 2. Are there **any other students or staff** associated with your facility who are experiencing **symptoms**, in addition to the initially reported case(s)?
- 3. Can you please inquire if the case(s) had close contact* with anyone at your facility during their infectious period (from two days prior to symptom onset [or first positive diagnostic test date, if asymptomatic] through at least 10 days after)?

*Close contacts are individuals who have been within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more with a person with COVID-19 or have had direct contact with fluids from a person with COVID-19 (for example, being coughed or sneezed on, sharing eating or drinking utensils), or have had direct physical contact with a person with COVID-19 (hugged or kissed them), or have provided care at home to someone who is sick with COVID-19.

- 4. How many students/staff have been identified as close contacts? Have they all been advised (as close contacts) to stay at home/quarantine (except for medical care) and self-monitor twice daily for symptoms THROUGH day 14 after their last exposure to a COVID-19 case? Please also confirm the current total number of school-associated close contacts (students and staff).
- 5. When were the case(s) last onsite?
- 6. Is/Are they currently self-isolating at home? If yes, through what date for each case?
- 7. If more than one case has been reported, can you please inquire if both (or more) cases were present in the same setting during the same time period (e.g., same classroom, bus, team, etc.) during the 14 days prior to their symptom onset/positive test date?
- 8. Do we know if either/any case is a close contact of another case either 1) in school or2) outside of school? If yes, which one, or both?

- 9. Do we know if there is **any other more likely source of exposure for both (or more) cases** (e.g., is any case a close contact to a confirmed case outside of the school setting)?
- 10. For the cases that **live in other counties**: can the nurse please confirm those cases are reported to the health department(s) where those cases live (e.g., Cook County Department of Public Health, Kane County Health Department, etc.)?
