6:05	<p>Professional Development Update</p> <p>The committee reviewed and discussed the professional development update for the 2020-21 school year as presented by Melissa Creech.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Glenbard PD continues to focus on equity, deep learning and instructional practice. • This summer and fall our professional development has focused on providing high-quality remote and hybrid instruction for all Glenbard students. • The PD offerings emphasized new technology tools, online collaboration, social emotional learning, unit design and assessments for remote learning. • Glenbard professional development has shifted online too, in both live and OnDemand formats. 6:15	<p>Curriculum, Data, and Standardized Assessments</p> <p>The committee reviewed and discussed updates to the curriculum, data and standardized assessments, as well as the updated Illinois State School Report Card as presented by Patrick McGill</p> <p>Regarding the Illinois Report Card, each school's designation on the Illinois Report Card in 2020 is the same as it was in 2019, due to the COVID-19 pandemic's impact on Illinois Report Card data.</p> <p>Patrick explained that 75% of the report card focuses on measures of academic performance and growth and the other 25% focuses on measures of school quality and success</p>	Patrick McGill

6:30	<p>New Online Course Proposal</p> <p>The committee reviewed and discussed the new online course proposal for the 2021-22 school year as presented by Melissa Creech</p> <p>The physical education department is proposing a new course for the 2021-22 school year called Online Wellness PE. Online Wellness is an elective Physical Education class available for juniors and seniors. It focuses on creating a personal fitness plan that focuses on individualized goals and components of fitness.</p> <p>This is the first proposed online course for Glenbard and will require new district-wide guidelines for online courses, in which at least 80% of the course content is delivered online.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Online courses will have the same minimum and maximum enrollment requirements as traditional courses. • They will be scheduled to a specific period and room in the teacher and student schedules. • Teachers will teach in-person from the assigned room and period each day. All online courses will meet in-person the first five days of the semester in order to build relationships and develop learning routines and expectations. 	Melissa Creech
6:40	<p>New Course Proposal Italian 4H</p> <p>This proposal for a new course Italian 4H was approved by the four department chairs for the department, all four assistant principals for instruction, and all four principals to be offered for the 2021-2022 school year.</p> <p>This course will be the bridge between Italian 3H and AP Italian Language. This course would be pre-AP with a focus on increasing proficiency through a variety of scaffolded AP like activities</p> <p>Currently Italian classes are only offered at Glenbard North, so this course would only run at North as a year-long World Language elective.</p>
