	The committee reviewed and discussed the overview of Glenbard student data on a variety of postsecondary metrics, including college enrollment, college persistence, summer melt, and college graduation	
	 Some of the postsecondary data highlights are: National trends show a decrease in college enrollment rates immediately after high school (-1.5% in 2019 and -6.8% in 2020), however Gllenbard college enrollment increased 2% for the Class of 2021. The Glenbard Postsecondary Support Counselors have helped to reduce student "Summer Melt" again, decreasing it by 4% from 2019-2021. Glenbard students who enroll in a 4-yr college have a 90% graduation rate within 6 years, compared to 63% nationally. 	
	Glenbard plans to Increase the focus on career exploration, in alignment with Glenbard learning opportunities and college and career pathways.	
	Our postsecondary and pathways initiatives will ensure that students have the most comprehensive college and career planning available as we strive to increase the postsecondary preparedness of all of our students.
