	<p><b>Review of Instructional Materials for 2022-2023</b> The committee reviewed and discussed instructional materials that will be used during the 2022-2023 school year. Highlights included.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There are 43 new textbooks and novels up for adoption for the 2022-23 school year. All new titles have been reviewed and approved by the Dept. Chairs in curricular areas, APIs and Principals.</li> <li>• Ten of the new titles are textbooks for Math, Science, Social Studies and Mandarin, while the rest are novels for English courses.</li> <li>• Several sources of free digital textbooks will be adopted by various curricular departments to enhance access to textbook resources.</li> <li>• The majority of the new novels are for student-choice literature circles, where students are offered a choice of several novels that all focus on a similar theme.</li> <li>• The literature circle titles are purchased in OverDrive which is the cost efficient way that allows Glenbard to purchase titles on demand</li> </ul>	Mike Fumagalli
