SAT Prep Update	Rebecca Sulaver
 In 2022, Glenbard delivered a 10-week comprehensive SAT Prep course for 749 11th graders with in-person and fully virtual options. The district wide average attendance rate increased from 66% in 2020 to 78% in 2022. This was a result of intentional attendance accountability efforts. We were also able to offer a bilingual cohort in which students received SAT Prep instruction in English with language support in Spanish from bilingual instructors. Glenbard students who attended 5 or more prep sessions had an average composite score growth of 76 points. 	
Glenbard plans to offer SAT Prep to 11th graders again in the 2022-23 school year through Academic Approach. Rebecca Sulaver will present this report to the Board on Oct 24	
Academic Approach Agreement	Rebecca Sulaver
Glenbard will partner with Academic Approach once again to provide an SAT Prep program that will include up to 31 sections across the four Glenbard schools, offering in-person and virtual instruction for 10-weeks. • The SAT Prep program with Academic Approach will provide 12 hours of Evidence-Based Reading and Writing and 12 hours of Math and offer 2 Practice Assessments during week 1 and week 5 of the program • Each student will also receive two digital manuals with over 400 pages each of skills-based lessons and full-length practice tests. • SAT Prep courses will be FREE to all Glenbard students. The Academic Approach agreement will be presented to the Board on Oct 24 for approval
