	One key metric Patrick reviewed was historical performance on SAT. While the % of Glenbard students scoring 1010 or higher on the SAT has somewhat declined in recent years, Patrick pointed out that Glenbard's average SAT scores consistently range 40+ points above the state average and Glenbard District scores near the top compared to other IL high schools Districts in the same low income bracket.

	Melissa reviewed the acceptance and participation rates in other students' awards and recognitions offered by Glenbard schools such as department awards, High Honor Roll, and Seal of Biliteracy. She reviewed the data in terms of proportionality of race and socioeconomic levels in class versus award category.
