	Directions End of Year Report The committee reviewed and discussed the Glenbard Directions program end-of-year 2024-25 report presented by Jordan Poll. Highlights included <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Directions Program offers a pathway to graduation for dedicated students looking to reconnect to school.• 74% of the Directions students are low income and 24% are English learners.• The Directions program graduated 62 at risk students in 2025. 67% of these graduates completed a college application. 	ACT Prep Update The committee reviewed and discussed the ACT Prep end of year report for 2024-25 school year, as presented by Rebecca Sulaver. The ACT Prep program provided students 18 hours of instruction over 11 weeks (Reading/Math/Science) and offered 2 digital practice tests during week 1 and week 6 of the program.
