Dear Ellyn Court Residents,

Glenbard West will welcome students back on Thursday, August 14th for the first day of school. In anticipation of construction starting this school year, we are implementing a new traffic management plan for campus. You can view a summary of the plan by scanning the QR code on the back.

Below you'll find directions on how best to enter and exit Ellyn Avenue during the school day.

- **Prior to 7:30 AM**

Ellyn Avenue is open both north and southbound to all traffic.

- **Peak Morning Traffic: 7:30 to 8:15 AM**

Ellyn Avenue will be barricaded at its intersection with Crescent Blvd and at the intersection of Hawthorne and Lenox. Buses will enter Ellyn northbound at Crescent Blvd and will queue in the right lane. **Ellyn Court residents (and delivery trucks bound for Ellyn Court) will be allowed to enter Ellyn northbound at Crescent using the left lane and exit Ellyn northbound to Hawthorne.**

- **During the School Day: 8:15 AM to 2:30 PM**

Ellyn Avenue will be open to traffic at its intersection with Crescent Blvd and will be one-way northbound only. **Ellyn Court residents (and delivery trucks bound for Ellyn Court) can enter Ellyn at Crescent and exit Ellyn northbound to Hawthorne.**

- **Peak Afternoon Traffic: 2:30 to 3:15 PM**

Ellyn Avenue will be barricaded at its intersection with Crescent Blvd and at the intersection of Hawthorne and Lenox. Starting at 2:30 PM, twelve buses will queue on Ellyn northbound in the right lane. Buses will exit campus by 3:10 PM. **Ellyn Court residents (and delivery trucks bound for Ellyn Court) will be allowed to enter Ellyn northbound at Crescent using the left lane and exit Ellyn northbound to Hawthorne.**

- **After 3:15 PM**

Ellyn Avenue is open both north and southbound to all traffic.

In an effort to minimize your inconvenience when entering and exiting the neighborhood, I have attached two placards to this letter. **Please place them on your dashboard during peak traffic times so that our staff can assist you through our barricades in the morning and afternoon.**
