## POLICY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Glenbard East West School

Monday, March 23, 2026

The Policy Committee held its monthly meeting at Glenbard West High School on Monday, March 23, 2026. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Quorum requirements were met and the meeting was able to proceed.

### **Approval of Minutes**

The minutes of the Policy Committee meeting for February 23, 2026 were reviewed.

Action: Motion made to accept minutes - Mazzolini, seconded – Mueller, and carried (all ayes).

### **Public Participation (Agenda Related)**

Hearing no requests to speak, public participation was then closed.

### **Items for Discussion**

Assistant Superintendent Chambers facilitated the meeting as the District administrator in attendance. Chambers stated that the agenda items were a continuation of Section 7 from the last meeting and a few from Section 8.

Policy 7:150 *Agency and Law Enforcement Requests (New Name)* - Changes in statute that went into effect 01-01-26 required changes to be incorporated into the policy to make sure it appropriately aligned and to meet guidance provided by P.R.E.S.S. Basically, the changes related to citizenship and student status.

Policy 7:190 *Student Behavior* - The only real changes in the body of the policy were suggested by P.R.E.S.S. under the Section for “Required Notices” pertaining to possession of a firearm on school grounds or threat of firearm violence. Legal references and cross references were updated.

Administrative 7:190-AP1 *Student Handbook - Hazing Prohibited* is a review only due reflect it is current with the policy – no changes were recommended at this time.

Administrative Procedure 7:190-AP3 *Guidelines for Reciprocal Reporting of Offenses Committed by Students* (New Name) – The procedure was rewritten and given a suggested new name by P.R.E.S.S. in response to 105 ILCS 5/10-20.14(b), amended by P.A. 104-430, requiring the parent-teacher advisory committee’s guidelines for reciprocal reporting to address both civil and criminal offenses committed by students.

Administrative Procedure 7:190-AP5 *Use of Isolated Time Out, Time Out, and Physical Restraint* was updated with new statute references and website URLs through the document

Administrative Procedure 7:190-AP8 *Student Re-Engagement Guidelines* had statute references updated and a reduction in the length of time a student is suspended out-of-school before the district must begin to provide appropriate services.

Policy 8:30 *Visitors to and Conduct on School Property* – The policy and legal references were updated in response to 105 ILCS 5/22-110, as part of revisions under P.A. 104-391. The changes within the document pertained to the exclusive bargaining representative agent, as well as enforcement sections.

Administrative Procedure 8:30-AP1 *Definition of a Child Sex Offender* had broader definitions incorporated. Previously it was very narrow and now it has been expanded so fewer people can access a school campus.

Administrative Procedure 8:30-AP2 *Community School Visitation* is a Glenbard unique AP, not found in P.R.E.S.S. It has not been reviewed in considerable time and suggested to have the current protocols used by the district stipulated.

Exhibit 8:30-E1 *Letter to Parent Regarding Visits to School by Child Sex Offenders* and 8:30-E2 *Child Sex Offender’s Request for Permission to Visit School Property* were form samples updated for continuous improvement as part of a five-year review by P.R.E.S.S.

Action: Motion made to move agenda items forward to the Board. - Mazzolini, seconded – Mueller, and carried (all ayes)


### **Public Participation (Non-Agenda Items)**
